School Uniform

Please ensure your child has our uniform in full – our policy is on the website (www.littlebollington.cheshire.sch.uk). I also take this opportunity to remind you to LABEL ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME – we cannot reunite lost uniform with it's owner if we don't know whose it is. We also ask that your child has a drawstring bag for their PE kit which hangs on their peg, and a school book bag – PLEASE DO NOT SEND IN RUCKSACKS AS THEY DO NOT FIT ON THE PEGS AND BECOME A HEALTH AND SAFETY ISSUE. The children also need trainers not pumps. All our information can be found in the parent's handbook and if you have any questions don't hesitate to get in touch.

Payments for Lunches, Trips, etc

We ask that, where possible, you make any payments online (details on the website) or by cheque. Please send any monies/cheques for snack, dinner money, trips, etc in named envelopes. Dinner money is posted in the secure box in the entrance hall on Mondays, all other money goes to your child's class teacher to enable us to run our accounts procedures.

Sharing Assembly

On Friday afternoons at 3.10 we have a sharing assembly to which you, friends and family, are invited. This gives you the opportunity to see what had been going on in school in the week in KS1 or KS2. Tomorrow each Key Stage will be showing work from the first 3 days.

Next week instead of sharing assembly at 2.45pm there will be a meet the teacher session where you will meet in the hall to hear about our website and new communication app, and then go to your child's class to meet their teacher, find out about class routines, etc.

Bollington Bears Toddler Group

Our toddler group is restarting at 2pm on Thursday afternoons, it is open to any parents and carers with children under school age. Two mums, Mrs Warburton and Mrs Marsland, are taking this forward but would welcome more of you to help at sessions. Please come along if you can and bring any friends and family along too.

Safety on the School Site

This week is an exceptional week with all our new starters so parking in the mornings has been a bit hectic – BUT NOT FROM MONDAY. Can I remind you NOT TO PARK ON THE SCHOOL CAR PARK UNTIL 8.40AM as staff parking is a priority up until that time as staff cannot leave classes to move their cars which have blocked people in, or just had to be left anywhere as there are no spaces.

We also ask that if you are not dropping your child off for our breakfast club that you DO NOT COME ONTO THE SCHOOL SITE and park in the drop off zone until 8.40am when drop off starts. Parking in the drop off zone really causes problems and congestion on the road which then heightens the risk for those waiting on the busy road to pull in.
