We have had several occasions recently where we have tried to contact parents ...only to find that the contact numbers we have are **NO LONGER LIVE AND WE HAVE BEEN LEFT HAVING TO FIND OTHER MEANS OF CONTACT OR JUST HOLD ONTO THE CHILD CONCERNED UNTIL COLLECTED.**

THIS IS A SERIOUS PARENTAL SAFEGUARDING ISSUE ... if your child was injured, taken seriously ill and needed medical treatment we WOULD NOT BE ABLE TO LET YOU KNOW which would cause your child great distress. PLEASE, PLEASE MAKE SURE WE HAVE UP DATE NUMBERS OF AT LEAST THREE CONTACTABLE people and THAT YOU INFORM US EACH TIME YOU CHANGE A PHONE NUMBER

We also ask that you put our school's number in your phone so as you know it is us who are calling – thank you.
