School Budget

As you will have heard in the news recently, school budgets are coming under increasing pressure as school funding is squeezed and costs have risen. At Little Bollington we pride ourselves in our rich and varied curriculum offered to all children and ensure that all activities we offer are subsidised by HSA and school funds. **However, we feel you need to know that we are currently carrying a debt of over £2000 due to outstanding trip payments, dinner money etc. IF YOU KNOW YOU OWE US MONEY PLEASE CONTACT MRS MASSEY TO AGREE DATES AND TERMS OF PAYMENT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!** Mrs Massey or myself will be contacting you personally if we don't hear from you. Tuesday 17th July Open Afternoon and Evening an opportunity for you to see your child's work, visit new classes/teachers and discuss your child's report.

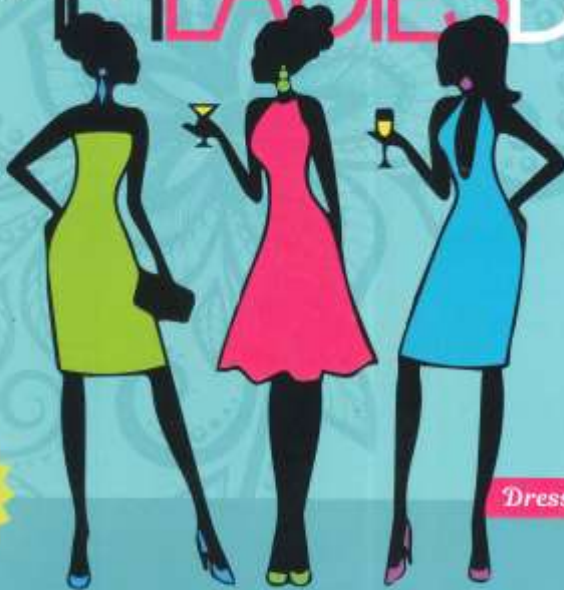
Thursday 19th July – Sports Day from 2pm.
