The Remembrance Weekend

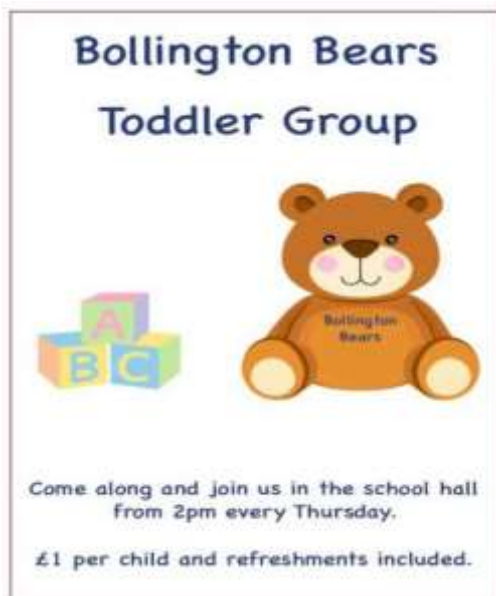
