Treasurers Report (please see attached sheet). The balance of the HSA bank account is £4,073.02. We discussed the HSA continuing to fund the coaches for school trips. On average we raise between £3000 and £4000 per year and with the costs of the coaches approximately £3,250 we needed to think if we can continue to fund the full amount as it would leave very little funds for anything else. After taking a vote it was unanimously decided to cover 50% of the coach costs for the next year and for it to be reviewed at the next AGM. All agreed that it needs to be made clear on the letters going out to parents the exact costs of school trips and how much the HSA is covering.

Parents need to know that the donations they make and the events they attend raise money for the HSA and in turn help to reduce costs of school trips which benefits and children.

Any other business: Mrs J requested new CD players for each classroom. Mrs J also talked about the science garden, help with funding and getting families involved in aspects of this with a bird box making morning. Mandy, Cara and Michelle asked for new hot water flask for events and coffee afternoons. Aldi tend to have them at this time of year, if in store we will purchase them.

We all agreed it might be a good idea for each class to have a parents whats ap group as not all parents use the school Facebook page.
